Registration & Fees

- **Corporate Floats/Walking Groups: \$50**
 - **All Other Entries: \$25**
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Fee Exemptions

- **Registered Nonprofits:** No fee with valid 501(c)(3) documentation (please email this to us).
 - **Marching Bands:** No fee.
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General Rules

- We do not accept current political election groups/candidates, or baton groups.
 - No performances where your group comes to a complete stop.
 - **Float designs:** All floats **must** submit a draft plan, including the design, for approval.
 - **Theme Adherence:** Entries that do not align with the parade's theme will **not** be permitted to participate.
 - **For-Profit Businesses:** If your group is tied to any for-profit business, or if your entry is advertising or distributing items from a for-profit business, you **must** pay the designated registration fee. You can still select a judging category if desired, but the fee applies if you meet these criteria.
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Payment & Deadlines

- **Registration Fee Due Date:** Your registration fee must be **received within 10 days** of completing this form at the address listed below.
- **Final Payment Deadline:** Payment is required within **7 days** of registration and is payable to: **Biglerville Borough 33 Musselman Avenue Biglerville PA 17307**
 - *Entries not paid within 7 days of registration will forfeit their space.*
- **Entry Form Deadline:** All entry forms must be received by **Friday, May 29th**.

- *Late entries may not be accepted. If a late entry is accepted, an additional **\$50** fee will apply.*

Vehicle Requirements

- Entries including a vehicle must provide a copy of the driver's license and proof of insurance.
- A driver must remain with your entry once parked in the formation area.
- A registration form and payment must be received for **each vehicle**.

Communication

- Rules and correspondence will be sent to the email address provided on your form. Please share all rules and information with everyone in your group.
- Entry numbers will be emailed no later than **Wednesday, June 10th**.

Parade Line-Up

- Entries may begin lining up at the Biglerville High School parking lot at **11:00 AM**.
- The parade will take place rain or shine.

Parade Day Instructions & Rules:

Staging Area & Line-Up

- Parade line-up will **begin at 11:00 AM**.
 - **No entries may enter the staging area before 11:00 AM.** There will be no exceptions.
 - The staging area will be at Biglerville High School on North Main Street.
 - **Portable restrooms** will be available in the staging area. Please **do not enter any school buildings/facilities**.
 - Properly dispose of all trash. Failure to do so may result in your group being disqualified from the parade.
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Float & Vehicle Rules

- You **cannot cover any portion of your windshield** with decorations.
- **Candy Distribution:**
 - I understand that my float/walking group **cannot throw candy** along the parade route.
 - Candy must be gently placed into bags or handed directly to parade-goers by walkers alongside the float/vehicle.
 - I will communicate this rule to everyone in my float/walking group.

- **Staging Area Entry Window:**
 - I understand that my group may only enter the staging area between **11:00 AM and 12:45 PM** on the day of the parade.
 - I will communicate this entry window to the rest of my group.

- I understand that if my entry includes a vehicle, I must provide a copy of the **driver's license and insurance card at the time of registration.**
- The driver must remain with the vehicle once it is in the staging area.
